

ISHYA Higher Education Scholarship Application Form

According to an all-India survey conducted in 2017-18 by the NSO group, it was reported that only 10.6 % of the Indian population above the age of 15 have successfully completed a graduate degree. One of Ishya Foundation's core goals is to be able to work towards fixing such disparities within sectors of education in India, especially for underprivileged students.

The Ishya Foundation is proud to be launching its very own Scholarship Programme and Mentorship for underprivileged students wishing to pursue higher education. The vision of our programme is to enable fairness within education by providing economic funding to bridge the gap for students who are unable to afford fees/resources for higher education. We will identify students with high academic excellence and provide sponsorship for their financial requirements, and mentorship guidance to help navigate their courses.

The whole degree course of 3-4 years will be sponsored within this programme subject to the students' performance in the college wherein they must be able to maintain their overall academic performance. For our first year of this project, we will be identifying 10 graduating students from class 12th examinations, who will be selected after our application process.

Colleges within Delhi University, and equivalent fee structures will be included in this sponsorship.

The criteria for the applicants is as follows:

- Applicant must have a good academic history, inclusive of high performance through grades IX - XII and the ability to get into the university of their choice.
- This scholarship programme is strictly only for underprivileged students from economically weaker sections who do not have the financial capacity or the economic means to fund their higher education.

The timeline for the application process can be noted as follows:

1. Students will be given a time duration of 3 months to fill out the detailed form, all questions within this form must be attempted. Form must be couriered to Ishya foundation.
2. The first shortlist will be released after the given duration and personal interviews will be conducted with each shortlisted student.
3. After interviews, the final 10 selected students applicants will be announced along with 5 waitlisted students.
4. Finally, the scholarship for the students will go through after the results for the Board Examination for the batch of 2022 are released.
